



LYC Bob Bayer Memorial Fishing Tournament

The Bob Bayer Memorial Fishing Tournament shall run from the first day of September through the last day of August the following year. All prizes and awards will be given at the annual LYC Awards Banquet held in September of each year. Only LYC Members are eligible for tournament awards. Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:

Largest Fish – A cash prize will be awarded for the first and second place entries in each category. Entry fee is \$5.00 per person per category. Prize money will include all entry fees in the category and will be awarded as follows: First place 2/3 and second place 1/3 of all money in each category. Prize money not awarded will carry over into the following year; however, entry fees are required each year to be eligible for that year's prizes. The first place winner in each category will also have their name engraved on a plaque that will be displayed in the LYC.

All entries must be certified by a LYC Dock Master or a certified tackle shop, marina or other certified weigh station. Entry fees must be paid before the fish is caught and only the angler catching the fish is eligible to enter the fish in any category.

Entry fees may be paid to any LYC Dock Master. To be eligible, the fish must be caught in Delaware waters or brought into a Delaware port. A leader board will be maintained in the marina building and leaders in each category will be posted on a bulletin board in the clubhouse lobby. Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:

- Flounder
- Croaker
- Bluefish
- Weakfish
- Striped Bass
- Tautog
- Spear fishing (largest fish) Off Shore (largest fish)

LYC Angler of the Year – The Angler of the Year Award recognizes achievement by a LYC member for outstanding sportsmanship, an exceptional angling year, contributions to the LYC boating community or any combination of the above. The award may be given to signify a single year's achievement or a culmination multiple year's accomplishments. The Chairman of the Marina Committee shall select the award recipient with input from Dock Masters and Committee Members. Winner of the Angler of the Year Award will have his/her name engraved on the Angler of the Year Plaque displayed in the LYC.
