Sailing News

The Sailing Committee met on Sunday, December 4th.

National Sailing Hall of Fame: The Chairman reported that a generous club member asked to hold a raffle (a gift basket of \$325 value) at the Craft Fair and Luncheon and raised \$415 for the NSHOF. Our total contributions are now \$4,815 toward our \$10,000 goal for LYC Founding Member listing at NSHOF. We were pleased to be advised by the NSHOF that our contributions are being matched by Bill Koch, the sailor and philanthropist (winner of the Americas Cup on “America3” in 1992). Look for a plea letter to go out in the next week or so. PLEASE HELP TO GET US TO OUR GOAL!! Thanks to everyone for their support!!!

Junior Sailing Camp 2012: Dates are June 18th, to August 10th. Sign up on the website will be available on or before February 1st. The format of the Junior Sailing Camp was discussed as far as providing a Race Day on Friday of each week. Also, an option for the non-racers would be an adventure sailing and cruising boat experience for that day. We are still considering the format and the Chairman will discuss this with Jay Kehoe at the Annapolis Yacht Club. Personnel were discussed and it was concluded that hiring an extra Sailing Instructor as a “floater” to cover instructor absence makes sense. Also, we decided to not have LYC Sailing Camp on Wednesday, July 4th (holiday) and instead have sailing races and un-regatta activities available (staffed by volunteers) and provide opportunities for sailing fun for the kids. We will be speaking to some older members to draw on their experiences.

Waterfront Director. We expanded upon the responsibilities of the Waterfront Director position and how this “Land-Based” director would coordinate scheduling, staffing, parent communications, purchasing and shore-based safety protocols and directing the overall program in conjunction with the Head Sailing Coach. The Chairman will develop a draft job description. Any member who knows anyone who may be interested in this paid position, please contact the Chairman!

Recruitment of Staff 2012: It is always a challenge to bring great Sailing Instructors to LYC for the summer. The Committee discussed the need for summer housing (as mentioned in our meeting with Jay Kehoe at AYC). We will discuss this summer housing issue with Nick Carter for some input.

J-70 Fleet: The Committee reviewed possible options for expanding the parking for sailboat dry storage and we walked the property. There is some great potential for additional parking behind the trailer parking area and adjacent to Maine Avenue. We also discussed some more reasonably-priced used-boat options (e.g. the J-24). More on this at the next meeting.

Rental Program: The Committee discussed the Sailboat Rental Program. Although it does not cover expenses (receipts approximately \$600 - expenses approximately \$1,200 for a summer staff member), we believe it to be a great program to encourage sailing and use of the boats and helps kids and parents to easily practice their sailing skills and have FUN on the Bay. It will be continued and the Chairman will discuss other responsibilities for the staff person to do grounds pick up, pool deck cleaning and parking enforcement on busy weekends.

Storage boxes at Marina and beach boat racks: Projects for spring are to build the Marina storage boxes and beach boat racks. HAVE YOU SEEN OUR NEW BEACH – WOW, 100 yards wide!!!! Lots of room for boat racks, rental racks for members and rental boat racks.

Cape to Cape Regatta, August 3rd, 4th and 5th: Look for a special event dinner on Thursday August 3rd in conjunction with our 80th Anniversary Celebration! More on this later.

Donations of Sunfish: We need to work out the details of the LYC Foundation - LYC Sunfish rental program concerning donated Sunfish sailboats.

Mobjacks: We discussed the Mobjacks and how to move some of our sailors into the Mobjack class.

Operational Audit Update

The Operational Audit that was sanctioned by the LYC Board of Directors is now in full swing.

CLUBWISE, our consulting firm, made an initial visit providing a background and indoctrination presentation to the LYC Board and Committee Chairs on November 7th.

A following site visit was recently concluded from November 28th through the 30th, wherein Jerry McCoy, CLUBWISE's principal, held sessions with LYC's leadership group and assisted in designing and formulating a Membership Survey, which has since been mailed to all members in the Lewes Yacht Club. The survey results will be tabulated and analyzed by Mr. McCoy over the holidays, with preliminary results and commentary expected upon his next site visit on January 12th through the 14th.

Additionally, LYC's Committee Chairs and Board Members have been asked to complete the Governance Checklist and sent directly to CLUBWISE. Along with the Members' Survey, the Checklist and Strategy Survey will be discussed at working sessions during Mr. McCoy's next visit. One-on-one sessions with Staff, Committee Chairs and others will also be conducted during this visit.

While not specifically scheduled at this time, there will be additional future site visits made to the Lewes Yacht Club by Mr. McCoy before the completion of the Operational Audit.

It is most important that all members complete the Membership Survey that was mailed in early December and return it to CLUBWISE no later than December 18th! Your input on this survey will be the foundation for determining the direction your Club will be taking in the coming months and years!

Finance Committee Report

LOAN RENEGOTIATION:

The members of the Re-finance Subcommittee have obtained a quote to refinance the Club's loans from one bank and are seeking bids from 2 other lenders. On receipt of these other bids, the Finance Committee will determine the best option for LYC, which may include staying the course with our current loans, and will make a recommendation to the Board at that time.

OPERATIONAL AUDIT:

John Campanelli reported on the status of the member survey and Mr. McCoy's return on January 11th for more training of club leadership and collection of information for his final report.

2012 BUDGET AND CASH FLOW REPORT:

The committee discussed a proposal to increase the Membership Activities budget in Department 90 from \$2500 to \$7500 for use by the 80th Anniversary Committee. The additional \$5000 would come out of the budget surplus, reducing it from \$20,091.25 to \$15,091.25. The Committee unanimously agreed to the change. The Finance Committee will add \$7500 to each 5th year budget for anniversary celebration use.

CAPITAL RESERVE FUND REVISIONS:

Dick Valeria reported that the two-horsepower circulating pump which is essential to keep the west end slips clear was anticipated to be replaced in 2013 for \$5000 and was so recorded in the 2013 Capital Reserve Fund, but the pump has failed. A service company will advise if it can be repaired, otherwise the CRF will be modified. The Finance Committee will add \$5000 to every 5th year for circulating pump replacement.

MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE SUGGESTION REGARDING NEW MEMBER INITIATION FEE PAYMENT:

Barbara Baker asked the Finance Committee to consider a Membership Committee proposal that would allow new members, other than legacy members, to pay their initiation fees over two years for an additional fee of \$200. The Committee saw the merit in the proposal, but raised a number of issues involving the details of the arrangement and budgetary impact and recommended that the Membership Committee return to the Finance Committee with documentation of the proposal. Barbara did not foresee a problem if the invitation letters were delayed until January.

ALTERNATIVE MEETING DATES:

The Committee discussed moving the meetings of the Committee to a weekend and concluded that other Committee meeting schedules and the unavailability of key members of the Committee made moving to a weekend day impractical.

FINANCE COMMITTEE STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE:

The Committee anticipates significant changes as a result of the Management Audit, so it prefers to delay revision of the SOP until a later date.

REVIEW OF SINKING FUND AND CAPITAL RESERVE ITEMS:

The Committee will review these items at its next meeting.

The Finance Committee is committed to offering great service to our members at a reasonable price – Value and Efficiency are our Goals. All members are invited to the monthly 5:00PM Tuesday night Finance Committee Meetings before each Board Meeting.
